## IQAC REPORT – 2008– 2009

**Part A (a)** :`

**Research:** Teachers and students of the college will be encouraged to take up active research. Teachers will be encouraged to attend conferences and seminars and present research papers. The college will make funds available to the teachers who will make outstanding achievements in this direction.

**Library:** The Reading facility in the library will be extended keeping in view the increasing demand of students. In the year 2008-09 the college plans to utilize the grant received from UGC for purchasing reading material for various subjects to enrich the library. The college is a proud recipient of special research grant meant for P.G. departments for various subjects.

**Outcome :** All that was planned in relation to library and reading facilities has been achieved.

In the year 2009-2010 the college plans to utilize the library facility provided to students to the fullest.

**Outcome :** In the year 2008-09 the expenditure incurred on buying books for the library is exceeded to budgetary allotment made at the beginning of the year. The total amount spent on Library books purchasing is Rs.618676/-.

The number of students who are making use of the 'Dnyanvardhan Granthalaya Yojana' has also increased and seven students of the college have to qualified the NET / SET examination during this year.

**Infrastructure:** The college plans to construct a new 'Ladies Hostel'. This is subject to availability of funds from UGC. The UGC has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 85 Lacs for such construction. However, the amount is yet to be received. The ALUMNI members of the Geography Department and others have offered to donate funds in order to renovate the rooms of hostels in which they stayed in their student days. Renovation of the 'B' block of the Hostels is complete. A **special Disabled - friendly arrangement** has been made in the first two rooms of the hostel which can accommodate more than eight students. The college plans to set-up a special research Lab in the Physics Department in view of receipt of grant of Rs. 36 Lacs by Dr. L.A. Patil from the DST.

**Outcome :** Such a lab.has been setup in department of physics which has now received another grant from **DRDO** which will be discussed in this report.

**Administration:** New Chairman has taken over the management of the college in January 2007.

**Outcome :** New appointments have been made and are being made in accordance with Government rules.

- **Administrative style, Quality management etc.**
  - ◆ The Internal Quality Assurance Cell has played an active role in Quality management.
  - ◆ The administration has also co-operated whole heartedly in its efforts.
  - ◆ The Quality assurance cell of 2007-2008 had to be changed because some members of the committee retired.

  - ◆ Excellent Teachers Award scheme. This scheme has been introduced to bring about optimum contribution of teachers in the all - round development of the College. This scheme will also help in quality improvement of the entire teaching process. Under this scheme the performance of teachers throughout the academic year is assessed on the basis of :-
    - ◆ The feed back provided by the students.
    - ◆ The feed back provided by the teacher regarding the various activities initiated and undertaken by him throughout the year.
    - ◆ These activities include all the academic (apart from classroom teaching) activities, co-curricular activities, research activities and extension activities undertaken by the teacher.

- ◆ The teacher is given citations and citation points for all these activities are added and it becomes possible to judge the contribution of each teacher objectively. The scheme provides for felicitation of the teacher who scores the highest total. By the end of the X plan we visualize the college teachers to be more innovative, enthusiastic, ready to take initiative and to work towards self development and the development of the college.     3. Major Research Project sanctioned by the UGC to Dr.Jyoti Rane, Dept. of English has been completed and submitted to the UGC.
    4. D.I.T. has sanctioned additional grants its 11 lacs more for Dr.L.A.Patil for his Major Research Project.
    5. Grant received from DRDO, Gwalior by Dr.L.A.Patil = Rs.15,00,000/-.

The aim of the college to provide internet access to every student, reading facility for every student through expansion of reading room, improved quality of education through administrative steering has been pursued.

The library has opened special sections to provide reading facility to outstanding students and P.G. students preparing for NET, SET and MPSC examination. These sections remain open in the college hours and beyond the college hours in the period of examinations.

**Part A (b) :****• Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution :**

The goals of the college as stated in its report submitted to NAAC are mentioned below. Activities reflecting the goals are mentioned in short. A detailed account of the activities can be found further in the report.

**G.1. To produce conscious and skilled scientists, social scientists, men of letters, artists, linguists, teachers, thinkers and social workers to build the nation.**

As can be easily deduced this is a broad goal encompassing all branches of the college and touching all aspects of academic and co – curricular activities undertaken by the college. The college does make a conscious effort to fulfill this goal by :

- 1) Arrangement of exhibitions and poster presentations, quiz competitions by various departments from the science faculty.
- 2) Arrangement of study tours by departments.
- 3) National and University level seminars for teachers and students are conducted by the Humanities section of the college. Students are encouraged to write for the Wall magazine and College magazine.
- 4) Art exhibitions are arranged and artistic output by students is displayed.
- 5) Students are encouraged and prepared for appearing for entrance examinations.
- 6) Students are provided opportunities to think freely on topics of social relevance and express themselves orally or in writing.

- 7) Students are given a taste of social work through activities conducted under NSS and NCC scheme. A detailed account of work done in this direction is given further in the report.

**G.2. To develop keen interest in scientific field :**

1. Students are provided well equipped science laboratories.
2. Students work in close proximity of teachers many of whom pursue active research in various fields related to science. Almost every department of Science stream has at least one recognized research guide. Students get an opportunity to come in contact with students doing M Phil. or Ph.D.
3. Project work is a part of syllabus of M.Sc. Physics, Geography, Zoology, Chemistry resulting in students getting first hand experience of research work.
4. Students are encouraged to arrange science exhibitions and participate in Science based competitions held in other colleges.

**G.3. To integrate Information Communication Technology (ICT) with conventional subjects in Arts, Science, Humanities, Languages and Social Sciences, to stimulate access to global knowledge and to promote relevant education and training :**

IT as special subject has been introduced in the curriculum of Commerce faculty. Students from other faculties are encouraged to take up courses such as DCM and MCM offered by the sister institutions of the college.

**G.4. To develop scientific attitude towards social phenomenon and to develop the skills of formulation, synthesis, analysis and argumentation in a variety of curricular and a mix of pedagogical approaches :**

The college arranges various activities for students in the form of debates, discussions, speech competitions, seminars and symposiums to enable students to develop a scientific and logical attitude. Similarly lectures by invited dignitaries on topics of social relevance such as water conservation environmental problems and scientific ways of countering such problems help the college to achieve this goal. Students are encouraged to take up research projects of social relevance. This year a group of students explored various aspects of patriotism and came out with a collection of research articles entitled 'A Vatan Tere Liye,'

**G.5. To encourage access to subjects in humanities and social sciences helpful to uphold the richness of local cultural values & to carry out groundwork for the betterment of society through inculcation of values by familiarizing students with great social thinkers and writers :**

The famous writer, freedom fighter and social activist Sane Guruji worked in Pratap Highschool in the precincts of the college. The college decided to establish a memorial of this great personality. The room in which he resided was used for this purpose.

It was decided that the birth anniversary of Vivekanand, Subhash Chandra Bose will be celebrated by the college. The birth anniversaries and death anniversaries of great social thinkers and writers are celebrated regularly. Students participate in these activities enthusiastically. This year students conducted speech competitions on such days. They remembered the contributions made by great social thinkers like Shri Babasaheb Ambedkar, Jyotiba Fule, Savitribai Fule, Shri Sane Guruji, Shri Pratap Shethji thus including national, regional and local luminaries who have been torch bearers for the society.

**G.6. To develop entrepreneurship, salesmanship and managerial skills among students & to integrate revolutionized technological advancement with commerce education to make commerce students conversant with modern trends in dynamic and competitive business world:**

The commerce department of the college plays a leading role in developing above mentioned skills in students through workshops and seminars. I.T. has also been made a compulsory subject for commerce students.

To impart education to develop leadership, sportsmanship, creativity, scientific temperament and citizenship for betterment to humanity & to promote the spirit of adventure, equality, liberty, fraternity and secularity.

All the healthy practices and teaching practices in the college aim at developing above mentioned qualities in students. The co-ed status of the college ensures gender-difference-tolerance and fosters values such as equality, liberty and fraternity. About 15% of the student population belongs to minority communities and S.C., S.T., N.T. & S.B.C. category. All these students learn to live together, work together and think together. The college is therefore an ideal place for development of secular values and encourages students to work together and think together.

**Part B (2) : New Academic Programmes initiated (UG and PG) :**

- **Dept. Of Electronics** : Two new courses initiated: Diploma Course in Electronics Equipment Maintenance Certificate course in financial Accounting.
- **Dept. of Geography** : P.G.diploma course – Data Analysis and Computer Cartographic Techniques.

- **Dept. of Hindi** : Certificate course in Translation.
- **Dept. of Microbiology** : From the current academic year 2008 -09 the dept has started M.Sc Microbiology. 14 students are admitted.
- **Department of Chemistry** : The department has started M.Sc. Drug Chemistry.

**Part B (3): Innovation in curricular design and transaction:**

In the present University system there is little scope for teachers to introduce new curricular innovations. However all departments try hard to attend workshops on Curricular design and transaction.

- **Dept. of Botany** : Ms. Latika Tahsildar as BOS member attended workshop on syllabus framing for SYBSc in NMU on 02.09.2008. All the staff members of the Dept of Botany were part of the Question bank committee in NMU on 19.09.2008.
- **Dept of Electronics** : Dr. D.S.Bhavsar is working as the chairman of BOS for Electronics, NMU Jalgaon. The syllabus for S.Y.Bsc, Electronics was framed and finalized under his chairmanship. Dr. Bhavsar has also framed the Question Bank for S.Y. B.Sc Electronics.
- **Dept. of Zoology** : Zoology staff members sent a letter to Dean, Registrar, BOS chairman, NMU , Jalgaon regarding practical examination in Zoology for improving the quality of examination. Staff members made suggestions while revising the syllabi of Undergraduate classes in the workshops conducted at different centres and also for M.Phil courses as follows:

- **Dept. of Geography** : Prin. Dr. S.R.Chaudhari is the member of BOS, Geography, NMU, Jalgaon so his contribution in curricular design is discernable. Chairman of M.A. I Geography Syllabus Framing Committee Designed all syllabi of M.A. Geography. Dr. M. B. Chavan was appointed as Chairman of following newly innovated curricular design.
  1. Geoinformatics – paper I
  2. Social and Cultural Geography
  3. Disaster management
  4. Practical – Human and Economic Geography(with the help of computer)
  5. Geoinformatics Paper II
  6. Advanced Cartographic Techniques with the help of Cad mapSoftware
  7. Geoinformatics paper III
  8. Application of GIS software in Geography practical with reference to Illwis Academic 3.4 and GPS
  9. Remote sensing and GRS
  10. Principle of population and Settlement Geography. In designing this curriculum the role of Dr. M.B. Chavan was very vital. With his Ten years experience in computer and GIS software, he himself has formulated these courses. These courses are innovated because they are totally based on computer application and nowhere in the state or even in the country such a curricular formula has been developed except in our University. The entire credit goes to Dept. of Geog. Pratap Collge. All these courses are job oriented and hence by taking these courses the students will get appointments in various IT companies. First two sem. Courses have already been implemented and commenced from the academic year 2008-09.

11. All staff members of the department have participated in syllabus framing workshops held at Shahada, Sakri, Parola, Amalner, M.J.College, Chalisgaon.
  12. In curricular design and transaction Dr.M.B.Chavan conducted teachers training for 5 days in Deptt. of Geography for practical course. Practical in Human Geography with the Deptt. of Computer.
- **Dept. of English** : Dr. Jyoti Rane, Mr. M.N.Sandanshiv, Mr. Nilesh Chitte attended a workshop at H.M. Patel Mahila College, Shirpur for syllabus framing at S.Y level for Compulsory English as well as Special English. – On behalf of the Dept Mr. Nilesh Chitte read out the following suggestions – Criticism as a branch of study should be introduced at S.Y.B.A level in G2 paper. This suggestion was accepted. Dr. Rane chaired a session in the workshop which dealt with syllabus framing for M.A –I. Mr. J.A.Shaikh, and Dr. Jyoti Rane attended a workshop for syllabus framing at Jaihind college, Dhule. Dr. Rane made a presentation regarding a possible format of syllabus for MA – I to be introduced in 2008-09. Mr.Nitin Patil attended a workshop at Muktainagar and made important suggestions regarding the syllabus to be framed for T.Y.B.A. and M.A. II.
  - **Dept of Microbiology** : Syllabus framing for S.Y B.Sc Biochemistry at Z.B Patil College, Dhule -13 Jan. 2008. According to suggestions regarding addition of few Microbiology topics in Biochemistry S.Y.BSc syllabus some topics like food preservation, food spoilage are incorporated. Syllabus framing for T.Y B.Sc MicroBiology at R.C.Patel Commerce, Science College, Shirpur on 9 Jan. 09. According to suggestions regarding addition of few new concepts in genetics of T.Y.B.Sc syllabus paper V : Techniques in Genetics and Viral genetics topics are incorporated. These suggestions were made by Mr. S.A.Joshi. These workshops were also attended by Ms. Hemlata Suryawanshi of the same department.

- **Dept.of Hindi** : On 20 Oct 2007 a workshop for syllabus framing was arranged for S.Y B.A and M.A –I classes. Participation in workshop for syllabus framing for- S.Y. B.A, T.Y B.A, M.A Hindi of NMU, Jalgaon by Dr. S.Y.Sonawane and Dr. Kalpana Patil.

- **Dept.of Statistics** : Dr. P.B.Bharate from the department is the Chairman of BOS in Statistics of NMU, Jalgaon & Mr. J.B.Jain is the member of BOS. By virtue of their position in BOS, they have contributed in designing the syllabus of Statistics at F.Y.B.Sc, S.Y.B.Sc and T.Y.B.Sc of NMU Jalgaon. The statistical softwares such as R-software, systat & VB net programming are incorporated in the syllabus. The new topics such as actuarial statistics is introduced at T.Y.B.Sc.
- **Dept. of Political Science** : The HOD of the Dept. Ms. S.S.Vaidya is a member of BOS NMU Jalgaon . She and all her colleagues participated in the process of syllabus framing for UG and PG. The syllabus framing workshop for MA-I and MA-II was held

at SSVPS college, Dhule on 4 March 2009. S.Y B.A syllabus framing workshop was held at Sant Muktabai Arts and Commerce College, Muktainagar on 10 Oct. 2007

**Part B (5) : Examination Reforms Implemented :**

From the year 2007-08 a new pattern of Examination has been introduced for students of Science and Arts streams. These Examination reforms have been brought about through the suggestions made by Mr. Shivaji A. Patil who is the Dean of the Science Faculty. The suggestions made by him are as follows:

- Examination reforms have been implemented as per the guidelines provided by the University by all departments of the college.
- **Dept. of Geography:** Prior to 2008 practical examinations were conducted traditionally but since 2008 due to the department's initiation the system of practical examinations have been reformed. The Practical examinations are conducted online. Therefore they are paperless.
- Practicals for MSc Sem. II and IV will also be conducted in similar way in future. The curricula of these courses and procedure of Examination system have also been approved by the BOS and University.
- **Geography Department** has not only introduced new courses based on Computers but also trained the teachers. This Dept has organized three –day intensive training course in the month of July 2008. In this training course ten lecturers of all P.G Departments (Geog.) in the jurisdiction of NMU participated. In this training course Dr. M.B.Chavan has trained and guided teachers and gave valuable guidelines for conduct in Practical examinations.
- **Dept. of Economics** objective type tests conducted for students every year. It was conducted on 03.02.2007, 30.1.08., 24.01.2009.
- Paper Reading programme for students (12 Jan,2008, 5 Feb. 2008 / 12 Feb. 2009)  
Quiz Competition for students On 20 Sept. 2008 in Pratap Centre of Philosophy.
- **Department of Commerce** the NMU Jalgaon introduced a 'Work Experience Scheme' for Commerce students from 1999. The participating students have to gain experience of practical work at site for four months. After the completion of the training period the students are required to submit a report and have to appear for a viva.

- In the year 2008-09 three students have submitted their project reports to the college. The students working under this scheme are required to visit different institutes or offices and firms like LIC, The Urban Co-operative Bank, offices of Tax Consultants etc.
- In 2008 -09 Internal Examination structure was changed. A system of Cumulative Grade point(CGP) was introduced. Students are now assessed according to their performance in Seminars and Group discussions.
- **Department of Statistics:** From the year 2008-2009 the annual 80-20 pattern for F.Y.B.Sc. and semester pattern for S.Y.B.Sc. have been implemented by the NMU and from 2009-2010 semester pattern will be introduced for T.Y.B.Sc. As a part of the system there is an internal examination system which needs to conduct class tests / seminars / tutorials. In addition to this the department conducts monthly tests / quiz for the students.
- **Department of Political Science :** The Department assesses the performance of students through tests, tutorials, seminars and Group Discussion at U.G and P.G level.

- **Abstract :-** The present invention to an improved process for the preparation of N6-(aminoiminomethy) – N2-3 (mercapto -1oxopropy - L - lysylgycy - L - asparty - L - tryptophy-L cysteinamide, cyclic (1-6)-disulfide of formula (1), which involves assembling amino acid residues and thioalkyl carboxylic acid with appropriate protecting groups on a solid phase resin, cleaving the peptide thus obtained from the resin with concomitant removal of side chain protecting groups except Acm protecting group of thiol moiety to obtained from peptide amide of formula (2), converting lysine residue of peptide amide of formula (3) having protected thiol group to homoarginine residue by guanylation to obtain peptile amide of formula (4), preparation of silver peptide of formula (5), followed by simultaneous deprotection and oxidation of the said silver peptide to obtain crude peptide amide comprising compound of formula (1) and finally subjecting of chromatographic purification. The described process is simple, easy, environment friendly and cost effective. Dr. Thakare has submitted another discovery and has applied for a second patent.

- Regular meetings with the Heads and members of the Departments will be convened and follow up action will be taken to ensure that the plans get translated into action.
- A tentative plan of action to be circulated among Heads is as follows –
  1. Maintain a record of the attendance of students in their respective subjects. Since it is not possible to devise a uniform method of recording attendance for all departments the head should, in consultation with other members of the department, devise a workable method of recording the attendance of students of their respective departments.
  2. To convene at least two parent body meetings (of parents of students from your department) in the academic year 2007-2008.
  3. To prepare a list of Alumni of the Department and to arrange a get – together of alumni, past and present members of the department.
  4. To submit at least one proposal for State/ National seminar on some topic related to your subject.

5. To encourage members of respective departments to use OHP and LCD in their regular teaching.
6. To form an association of students for their respective subject and to conduct activities such as i. quiz, ii. Exhibitions iii. Discussions iv. Lecture by guest lecturers etc.
7. To encourage students to take advantage of facilities provided by the college such as i. the internet facility ii. The library facility iii. Books on competitive exams etc

- **Research:** Teachers and students of the college will be encouraged to take up active research. Teachers will be encouraged to attend conferences and seminars and present research papers. The college will make funds available to the teachers who will make outstanding achievements in this direction. In the year 2007-08 students of Humanities. worked on a research project-“A Vatan Tere Liye”. They have brought out a volume of essays on the topic. Another team of researchers will take up research on other similar topic.
- **Library:** The Reading facility in the library will be extended keeping in view the increasing demand of students. In the year 2007-08 the college plans to utilize the grant received from UGC for providing Coaching to students belonging to Minority Communities for entry into services to set-up a library consisting of study material specially meant for students preparing for competitive exams.
- **Infrastructure:** The college plans to construct a new ‘Ladies Hostel’. This is subject to availability of funds from UGC. The UGC has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 85 Lakh for such construction.

The building of the college is old and the college plans to take up renovation activities on a large scale.

- **Administration:** New Managing body will has taken over the management of the college in March 2009. The college plans to appoint new teachers in various departments of the college in the year 2009-10.
